**Suicide Prevention & Postvention Protocol for Schools and Colleges-** This protocol has been developed to help schools and colleges in Hampshire identify and support students who may be suicidal and importantly to consider a wide range of associated issues, in the case of a death by (suspected) suicide. It both supports schools/colleges to prepare in case there ever is a (suspected) suicide, and also how to best respond when a suspected suicide has taken place. The protocol was approved by HSCB and will be rolled out in all schools, including independents across Hampshire.

**CAMHS Presentation** -Sussex Partnership Trust presented on the CAMHS service provided within Hampshire. The service provides seven community teams, one county wide eating disorder team and one urgent assessment and home treatment team. During 2016/17 there were 8405 referrals. The main presenting difficulties were; Anxiety, depression, neurodevelopmental assessments, trauma and risk taking behaviour such as self harm, interpersonal violence and risk of CSE.

**[Safeguarding Supervision Principles](#)**- Following a recommendation made as part of the Serious Case Review for Child M a Safeguarding Supervision Principles document was produced. The document was endorsed by HSCB and is available on the HSCB website.

**Update and progress on the 2017/18 HSCB Business Plan-** A presentation was given to HSCB providing an update on the five priority areas of the 2017/18 Business Plan. These include; Neglect, Trigger Trio, Key Safeguarding Themes, Scrutiny and Improvement and Engagement.

Good progress has been made in each of the five areas with further work scheduled for quarter four.

**2018/19 Budget-** The HSCB 2018/19 budget was agreed with partners committing to contribute the same funding as 2017/18.

**2018/18 Training-** The 2018/19 Training Plan was endorsed by HSCB with costings and agency contributions remaining static for the year.
